

ECEC Pre-School Teacher Position

St. Vincent's is seeking a full-time (40 hours a week) Pre-School Teacher at its Early Childhood Education Center. Since 1858, St. Vincent's has been providing affordable, quality childcare in a safe, loving, and nurturing environment. The Center is open year round and is licensed for infant, toddler, and pre-school age children.

This position requires a minimum of 24 ECE units. Candidates should have an AA/AS or BA/BS in Early Childhood Education, or be working towards their degree. Teacher permit is a plus. Candidates must have a current First Aid/Pediatric CPR certification.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Minimum qualifications for this position are:

- 24 units in E.C.E. including core courses (3 Infant/Toddler units required for Infant Toddler Teachers), or related degree
- 6 months teaching experience (lab experience is acceptable)
- Community First Aid/Pediatric CPR certification
- Commitment to ongoing education in the field of Early Childhood Education
- Ability to work independently with a strong level of organizational skills.
- Must possess excellent interpersonal communication skills and ability to work with all levels of clients
- Possess good writing, speaking skills.
- Demonstrated leadership at professional level
- Must demonstrate personal identity with and commitment to the Mission and Values of St. Vincent's.
- Is conscientious in follow-through on job requirements and has the ability to be a self-starter.
- Possess the ability to generate enthusiasm and inspire confidence and support

Must pass criminal background fingerprint check and pre-employment negative TB test. Vaccinations must also be up-to-date, and immunization records provided.

Position is non-exempt, hourly and is scheduled for Monday through Thursday 8:30 am to 5:30 pm and Friday 8 am to 5 pm.

Compensation depends on experience. Benefits eligible position after 60 days including health insurance, dental insurance, vision insurance, life insurance, retirement plan, gym stipend, paid time off (PTO), education reimbursement, and paid holidays.
