

## Lifeguard

St. Vincent's is seeking a part time lifeguard to work at our private aquatic facility on campus for residents. Must be able to work up to 12 -15 hours per week, with afternoon shifts Monday - Friday, and mornings and afternoons on Saturday.

The Lifeguard is responsible for maintaining a safe environment for swimmers at the St. Vincent's Pozzo Aquatic Center. Lifeguards will be responsible for completing daily pool operation tasks such as opening and closing checklist, pool inspection with chemical log, checking swimmers in and out, conducting swim assessments as needed, orienting new swimmers to the pool facility and the safety and rescue of patrons in and around the pool at all times.

- Must possess a current certification in Lifeguarding, First Aid, CPR, and AED. Water Safety Instructor certification desired, but not a requirement.
- At least 1 year experience in being a Lifeguard and water safety programs.
- Must abide by and enforce all of St. Vincent's policies, procedures, rules, and guidelines for pool users.
- Must possess excellent interpersonal communication skills and ability to work with all levels of clients.
- Evidences a high degree of sensitivity to issues and to persons. Ability to work with a diverse multi-generational community.
- Is conscientious in follow-through on work assignments and has the ability to be a self-starter.
- Must demonstrate personal identity with and commitment to the mission and values of St. Vincent's.
- Must pass criminal background and fingerprint check, pre-employment physical with negative TB test, and have a valid California Driver's license with clean DMV record.

Compensation depends on experience.

Must pass criminal background fingerprint check and pre-employment negative TB test.
